

Dear Parents,

We are very excited about the rapidly approaching 2010 season and our Big Trips for Intermediate and Sub-Senior campers! (Inters are boys finishing 7th grade, going into 8th. Subs are boys finishing 8th grade, going into 9th.)

Intermediates will be going on a four day trip to Cape Cod and Martha's Vineyard. If your son has permission to take this trip, please indicate on the Permission Form, sign, and return with a check for \$475 in the envelope provided.

**Parents of Sub-Senior campers, please take special note of their choices.** On July 12, Sub-Seniors will participate in a social with the girls from Camp Vega, then join them on July 13 for a day of whitewater rafting. The cost of the trip is \$100. Please check where indicated to grant permission. **Please also fill out and return the Moxie Whitewater Rafting Participation Agreement with our Big Trip form.**

Sub-Seniors have *two weeks of Big Trips!* The first week is a choice of one of the following: Saint Croix River Canoeing Trip, Mount Katahdin Trip, Acadia National Park Trip, or Golf Trip. These trips are real camping trips and wonderful experiences. The dates and cost of each trip are indicated on the Permission Form. **(Please tell your son that he may change which of these four trips he chooses after he gets to camp and has a chance to speak with his friends and bunkmates.)**

During the second week, Sub-Seniors may participate in the five-day trip to Quebec and Montreal. This trip runs from August 2 through August 6.

**If your son will be taking one or more of these trips, please indicate on the Big Trip Permission form, sign, and return with a check in the appropriate amount in the enclosed envelope. We must secure reservations at this time, so your prompt attention is appreciated.**

As indicated on the Permission Form, all of these trips are completely optional and are billed at exact cost. Campers who choose to remain in camp will participate in a full camp program.

**Also, please notice the Special Note regarding R-rated movies** on the permission form. Occasionally, we take the Senior campers to the movies (or show videos in camp) and want to make sure your son has permission to see R-rated movies which we consider appropriate to their age and maturity level. **Please check the appropriate box on the form. (If you do not want to grant permission, please be assured that we will *not* single out any individual camper.)**

If you have any questions or would like to discuss any of this further, please don't hesitate to call and speak with Warren or me. You can reach us in New York until June 5<sup>th</sup> and at camp after that.
